

#### **DIRECTIONS TO OAKS CLUBHOUSE**

3701 Oaks Clubhouse Drive in Pompano Beach, FL (954) 978-6066





(Note: There is no Atlantic Blvd. exit for south-bound drivers on the Turnpike. Please refer to directions below.)

Turnpike Traveling South – Take Exit 67 (Coconut Creek Parkway / Martin Luther King) in Pompano Beach. Cross through the first intersection and follow signs south to Atlantic Blvd. Turn left and head east; at the second set of traffic lights (Powerline Rd.) turn right. Continue south on Powerline Rd. for a few minutes to McNab Rd (NW 69<sup>th</sup> St.)- just after the Texaco gas station.) Turn right on McNab and head west until SW 36<sup>th</sup> Ave (just after FEDEX). Turn right and head north on SW 36<sup>th</sup> Ave. (Passing Publix & Skolnick Center on right) to W. Palm-Aire Dr. (4-way stop). Turn left onto W. Palm-Aire Drive & go west for ½ block. The Oaks Clubhouse (Cypress Room) will be on the right. Follow Signs into Parking Areas; Valet or Self Park.

Turnpike Traveling North – Take Exit 66 (Atlantic Blvd.) and turn right (east). Continue east along Atlantic Blvd. and at the third set of traffic lights (Powerline Rd.), turn right. Continue south on Powerline Rd. for a few minutes to McNab Rd (NW 69<sup>th</sup> St.)- just after the Texaco gas station.) Turn right on McNab and head west until SW 36<sup>th</sup> Ave (just after FEDEX). Turn right and head north on SW 36<sup>th</sup> Ave. (Passing Publix & Skolnick Center on right) to W. Palm-Aire Dr. (4-way stop). Turn left onto W. Palm-Aire Drive & go west for ½ block. The Oaks Clubhouse (Cypress Room) will be on the right. Follow Signs into Parking Areas; Valet or Self Park.

I-95 Traveling North or South – Exit at Cypress Creek Rd. West. Head west to NW 21st Ave. Turn right (just before Calvary Chapel) and head north on NW 21st Ave, crossing McNab. (Note: After crossing McNab, the road name changes to SW 36th Ave.) Keep heading north on SW 36th Ave., (Passing Publix & Skolnick Center on right) to W. Palm-Aire Dr. (4 way stop). Turn left onto W. Palm-Aire Drive & go west for ½ block. The Oaks Clubhouse (Cypress Room) will be on the right. Follow Signs into Parking Areas; Valet or Self Park.

In 4+ years, Cummings had by far the fewest failed inspections amongst all the contractors working on Airport Projects at the Ft. Lauderdale/Hollywood International. They participate in the annual BOIEA Golf Tournament at a sponsorship level. They built the College of Engineering and Computer Science Building at Florida Atlantic University's Boca Raton Campus. The 5-story, 93,924 SF College of Engineering building consists of a circulation lobby, lecture rooms, laboratory/classroom teaching areas, computer server housing, distance learning classrooms, faculty offices and multiple student areas. The design theme is "Engineering on Display" with system components on interactive display throughout the building and it is unique in the fact that it achieved a Double LEED Platinum Certification.

## **Board of Rules and Appeal**

Frank Bernardo of Engineering Express has developed a computer program that will allow you to search all Miami-Dade product approvals and Florida product approvals. You can search by product approval number or better yet, you can enter a product such as windows and a pressure criteria such as +40 psi and -35psi and the program will find any and all products which have been approved that match that criteria. Frank has authorized the Broward County Board of Rules and Appeals to have a link to this program on our website as a public service.
